“I thought it was too good to be true at first. But it was exciting once we started employing people from the neighborhood. It felt like we were creating the change we had been promised for so long.”

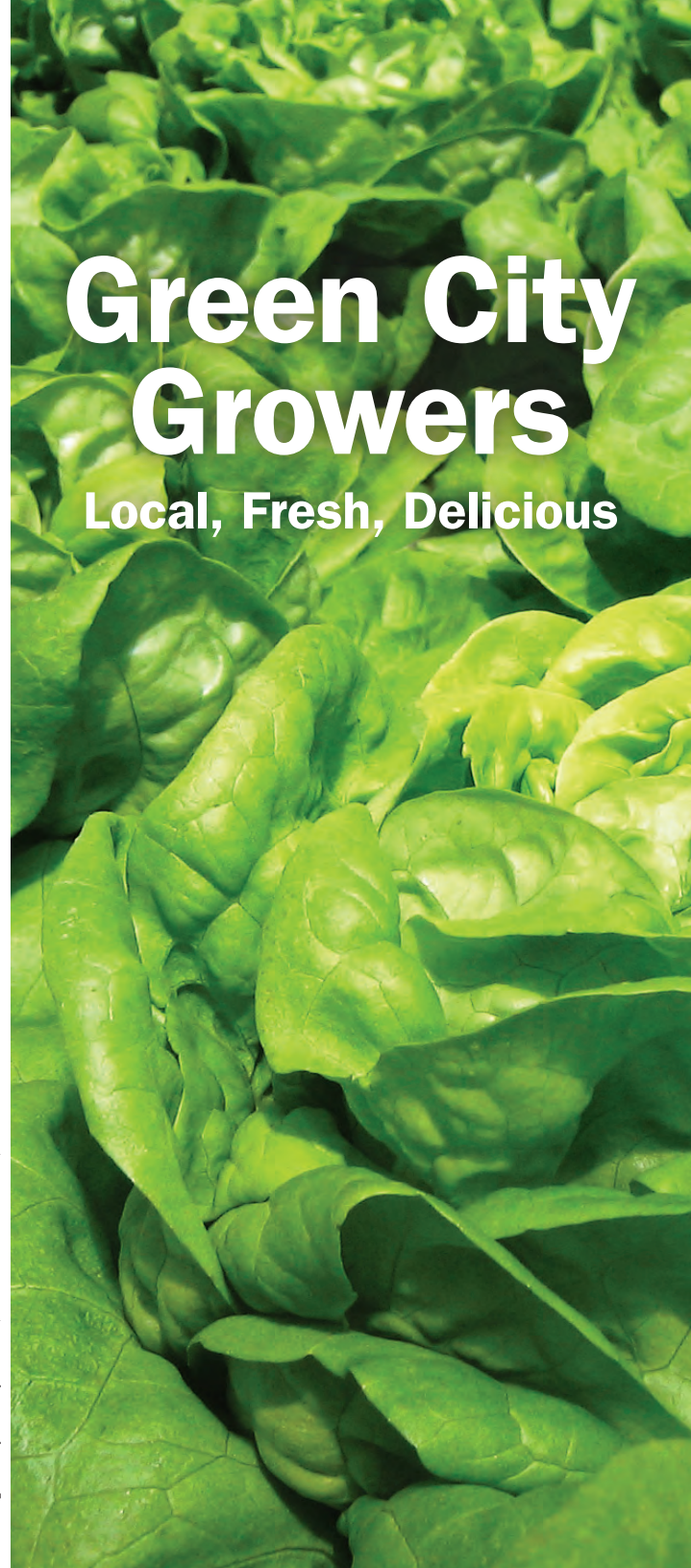

A commercial greenhouse, Green City Growers will produce 3 million heads of red leaf, green leaf, and Boston (Bibb) lettuce and 300,000 pounds of herbs each year for grocery stores, institutions, distributors, and consumers.

Plants grow hydroponically, in shallow ponds of nutrient-rich water rather than soil. Our workers wear lab coats, not overalls.
